



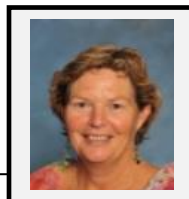

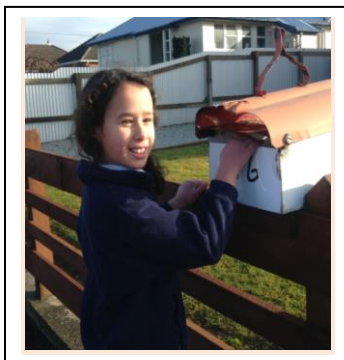
Here we are half way through the school year – a very scary thought.

Other children with no referrals had a special game time during their Kiwi Can time.

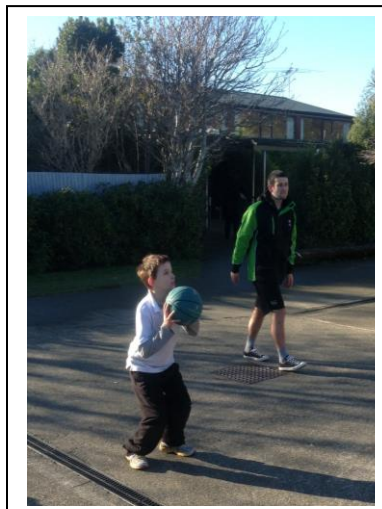


Kiwi Can 10th Anniversary:

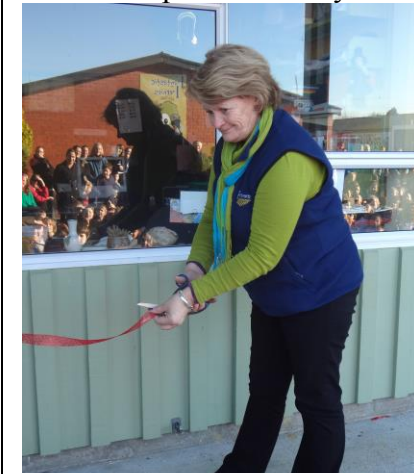
Book Week and Library Renovations:
